

Cookies Policy

When accessing the <https://www.belgianfibers.com> website (the “Website”), cookies may be installed and temporarily stored on your hard drive to ease your browsing.

A cookie is a text file placed during the consultation of a website, stored in a specific space of the hard drive of your computer or your mobile device. Cookies are managed by your Internet browser and only the issuer of a cookie can decide to read or modify the information contained therein.

Cookies have several functions, such as allowing you to navigate efficiently on a website and remembering your browsing preferences or the pages of the website that you have visited.

A cookie allows its issuer to recognize your terminal and to collect a certain amount of information relating to the navigation carried out from this terminal.

Cookie List
